- **Applicant must register with FCC CORES and use their FRN.**
- NCVEC Form 605 must be completed by the candidate and will be provided and also may be downloaded from the ARRL VEC (http://www.arrl.org/files/file/VEs/605%20Form_2020_Fully%20Interactive.pdf).
- Examinees must present personal picture ID (no exceptions).
- If licensed, original and photocopy of current FCC license and/or CSEs.
- Exam fee as allowed by FCC.
